



# INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING BERKS QUILTERS GUILD NAME TAGS

## MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 2 - muslin or solid beige fabric, pieces cut  $5 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 3 \frac{3}{4}''$
- 1 - thin batting cut  $5 \frac{1}{4}'' \times 3 \frac{3}{4}''$
- 16 - 2'' squares, assorted colors
- 1 - 22'' (or more) piece of either bias or straight of grain fabric for binding
- Thread, needles, etc.
- Fabric pen for lettering; or if you prefer, cross stitch or embroider your name

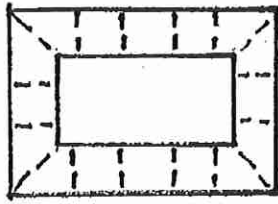
## STEPS:

1. On top muslin layer, mark an inner rectangle 1'' from all edges. Center your first and last name and complete the lettering style of your choice.
2. Place batting between layers of muslin and quilt the 1'' border. Add some quilting to the edge. Quilt around outer edge.
3. To make the prairie points, fold each 2'' square on the diagonal. Fold in half again, matching raw edges. Press.
4. Arrange prairie points as shown in illustration; as you add the next prairie point, slip it between the two layers of the previous point.
5. Trim corner edges. Stitch binding  $\frac{1}{4}''$  seam, turn and slip stitch in place on back.
6. Add safety pin to back to pin on clothing or add cording to hang around neck.

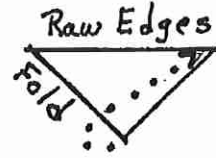
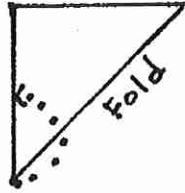
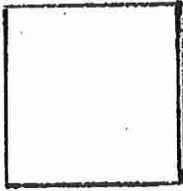
